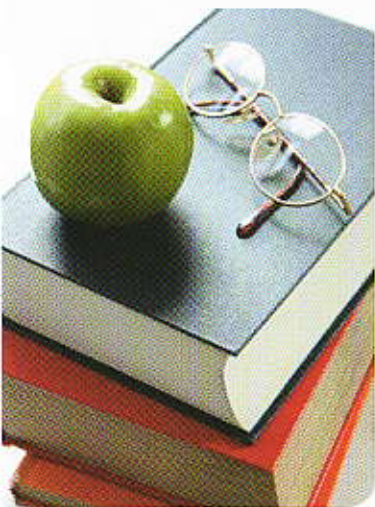
Nobel Academy Secondary School offers an alternative opportunity for students to earn an Ontario Secondary School Diploma.
